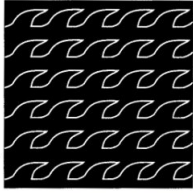


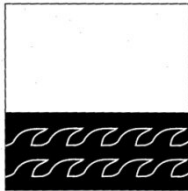

Gen 2:2 Now the earth was formless [*tohu*] and empty [*bohu*] ...

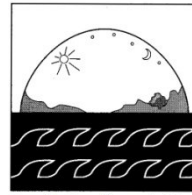

Day 1: Light

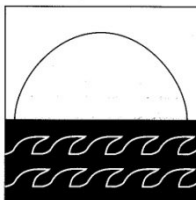
